► **Bible Point**
Help others see Jesus.

Key Verse

“In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven” (Matthew 5:16).

We learned today that Jesus said we are to be “the salt of the earth” and “the light of the world.” We also learned that when we let our light shine before others, they see the good things we do and praise God (Matthew 5:13-16). Strengthen your family’s faith learning and growth at home with this easy idea.

Commit to sharing the light of Jesus in one of the ways discussed. Then encourage each other throughout the week to share how you’ve followed through on being salt and light to the people around you.
