Protection Policy Revisions

- Instead of having only one document - have created 2 documents - Protection Policy and Guidelines for Best Practices (guidelines are more easily revised when changes are needed). Made some changes - completing an annual online course now instead of a workshop Guidelines: job descriptions (will change), methods of keeping attendance (using a digital, webbased program instead of paper), first aid kits, forms (attendance sheet, medical release forms, etc.) - minor changes
